CODE BLUE BUS STOPS:

All guests should be at a bus stop by 8:00 pm. Pick-up times do vary based upon weather and number of passengers, but a bus will get to each of these stops. *Please be patient!*

- **Bucks County Opportunity Council Building (BCOC)** bus stop is in front of building, at far corner from front door, by neighbors fence. Guests should wait under building light.
- **County Way** bus stop at the second stop sign (*at the intersection of Library Way*) coming from New Falls Road, near Five Points in Levittown.
- **Levittown Town Center** on Route 13, the vacant lot parking area closest to Rte 13, across from Home Depot/Arby's.
- **Edgely Rd & Penn Ave** on the corner at the stop sign across from the Edgely Firehouse just off Route 13 *Address: 1200 Edgely Ave., Penndel*
- **Morrisville*** at the parking lot at the intersection of Bridge & Pennsylvania Ave near 7-11 convenience store in Morrisville. *Address: 303 West Trenton Ave., Morrisville*

*Guests needing to be picked up from Morrisville should leave a message w/ name & phone # at 215-550-3868 ext. 100 before 5:00pm to ensure we can get a bus out to you. *Any message left after 5:00pm, we will do our best to get transportation out to you, still leave your name & phone number and someone will get back to you.*

WHEELS TO MEALS BUS STOPS: (2 trips maximum each bus)

- **Bucks County Opportunity Council Building (BCOC)** bus stop is in front of building, at far corner from front door, by neighbors fence. Guests should wait under building light. *Address: 721 Veteran's Hwy., Bristol*
- **Edgely Rd & Penn Ave** on the corner at the stop sign across from the Edgely Firehouse just off Route 13. *Address: 1200 Edgely Ave., Levittown*
- **County Way bus stop**, at the second stop sign (at the intersection of Library Way) coming from New Falls Road, near Five Points in Levittown. *Address: 6 County Way, Levittown*
- **Levittown Town Center** on Route 13, the vacant lot parking area closest to Route 13, across from Home Depot/ Arby's *Address: 177 Levittown Parkway, Levittown*

****REMINDER****

When the Code Blue shelter is OPEN, there will be **NO AHTN BUS transportation** to the Free Shared Meal scheduled for that day. (*This also includes weekend meals*). Guests with their own means of transportation are still welcome to attend the shared meal offered that day.

The Drop-In Center is open Monday- Friday from 8:00am to 6:00pm for anyone who is unsheltered. At the center, you will have access to showers, washer/dryer, resources from other agencies for additional help along with other supplies. There is a TV and computer access too. A light meal is also offered for lunch. Transportation is offered by Reach Out each day they are open. Guests should be at an AHTN bus stop at 10:00am for pick-up. Drop-off is at 4:00pm.

Clothing Needs: Free clothing may be available to those in need through AHTN partnership at local thrift stores. Please contact our Resource Consultant, Amanda 215-550-3868 x101 so that she can make the request for you. **Guest MUST make the request through AHTN first** as you cannot go to the thrift store yourself to make the request. Also, should you need transportation to the store, let Amanda know so she can try to make arrangements for an AHTN Volunteer to take you.



UNITED WAY offers many resources for those in need such as food banks, rent & utility payment assistance along with Physical & Mental Health Resources. They support older adults with transportation & health care.

If you are looking for a job, they also offer job training, educational programs and financial assistance for education.
